## Mentoring and Leadership Council

The MLC has met monthly as a whole team since the 2023 convention. Sub-teams have met in between these meetings to discuss particular topics/initiatives. Our activities have centered around planning for the 2024 convention and promoting mentoring and leadership related opportunities and information.

## **Curating Mentoring-Related Resources**

Our Council has been working on curating a set of resources related to mentoring –especially academic mentoring to be housed on the upcoming revised NCA website. The resources we are collecting include: mentoring awards that are being given interest groups and caucuses; peer mentoring programs, activities, sessions; conference mentoring events, activities, panels; links to mentoring books, materials, tools, and websites.

We are involved in the development of membership value enhancement through offering content and opportunities related to mentoring via the new website. These conversations are ongoing.

## **Conference Plans**

We have created some "pre-convention buzz" about mentoring through an article entitled, "Making Mentorship Matter More: Mentorship & Leadership Council Programming at the 2024 NCA Convention in New Orleans" that will be circulated in various communications from NCA comms team.

Most of our labor has been focused on planning for the 2024 convention panels. We did solicit nominations from the membership for our third panel below through the NCA newsletter. At the convention we will sponsor three sessions (and a business meeting) and will co-sponsor a set of other sessions.
