Sample Generative AI Assignment

Nonverbal Communication

For this assignment, you will engage in a conversation with an AI assistant (<u>Claude</u>) to explore how artificial intelligence overcomes the challenges of communicating without eye behavior, gestures, and tone of voice.

Instructions:

1. Initiate a conversation with Claude using the following prompt. You must fill in the blank. You can talk about your hobbies, music, baking, shopping, classes or anything.

Claude, pretend you and I are friends. Your job is to carry on a conversation with me on the topic of my choosing. The topic I want us to converse about is _____. I will begin the conversation. You can respond with questions and statements as though you are my friend.

- 2. When conversing with Claude, pay attention to how the lack of nonverbal cues affects your conversation. Consider the following questions:
- a. Eye behaviors: How does the lack of eye contact impact your interaction? Does Claude compensate for this absence? Does it matter?
- b. Gestures: In what ways does Claude's lack of gestures impact your conversation? Is Claude able to emphasize meaning or add meaning without gestures? What does Claude do?
- c. Tone of voice: In what ways does Claude convey tone without speaking? What textual cues or language choices does Claude use to express emotion, emphasis, or attitude?
- 3. Experiment with different communication styles and observe how Claude responds. For example, try using emojis, all caps, or varying punctuation to see how Claude interprets and responds to these cues.
- 4. After your conversation, write a 500-word discussion post addressing the following:
 - Briefly describe your interaction with Claude.
- Analyze how the absence of traditional nonverbal cues affected your communication.
- Discuss the strategies Claude used to compensate for the lack of eye behaviors, gestures, and tone of voice.
- 5. Make sure to use examples to support your analysis.
- 6. Respond to two other students within two business days of the due date. Your first comment should be to a student who has no other comments. What did you learn from your classmate? Did their analysis reveal something that your analysis did not?
